REGULATIONS

1. DATE OF REGISTRATION: SEE RULE 1 IN GENERAL RULES.

Late entries in the LIVESTOCK DEPARTMENT, if accepted, will be charged double the amount of the entry fee. None accepted after September 1 at midnight.

NO REFUND WILL BE MADE AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE. A \$25.00 charge will be assessed for checks returned from the bank for any reason.

2. Entry form must be completed in full for proper placement in classes.

3. No exhibitor may enter more than eight birds of a variety, but may enter as many varieties as desired.

4. Entry fee of \$3.00 for singles and \$5.00 for trios. Exhibitors will be responsible for feeding and watering birds until judging is complete. See Poultry Superintendents for special considerations.

5. Bird check-in begins at 9:00 A.M. Wednesday, September 28. All birds must be in place by Noon Wednesday and remain on exhibit until 4:00 P.M. Saturday, October 1.

6. Any exhibitor tampering with the folded cards, discussing the merits of their birds with the judge prior to the placing of the awards, or calling attention to their own entries in such a way that it might be construed as trying to influence the judge, shall be ruled ineligible for any and all awards, and entry fees shall be forfeited. For sale signs may be placed on coops only after judging is completed.

7. The American Standard of Perfection as adopted by the American Poultry Association shall be the guide of the Judge in awarding premiums to be judged by comparison.

8. As required by a regulation adopted by the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission January 9, 1975, "all poultry in fairs must be accompanied by a health certificate showing that they have been tested for Pullorum and found negative or document showing they originated in Pullorum Free flocks, which have been tested according to the National Poultry Improvement Plan."

No birds will be allowed to enter the grounds without proof of negative testing.

9. Birds showing any signs of disease will not be accepted for exhibit.

10. Coops and feed will be furnished by the management.

11. ALL BIRDS MUST BE PROVIDED WITH LEG BANDS AND THE BAND NUMBERS MUST BE STATED ON THE ENTRY BLANK; OTHERWISE, THE SUPERINTENDENT CANNOT IDENTIFY THE BIRDS AND THEY CANNOT BE JUDGED. ENTRY WILL BE RETURNED WITHOUT LEG BAND NUMBER.

IMPORTANT: Out of state poultry must have a negative blood test and & health certificate from a veterinarian.

Entries in this department are open only to exhibitors who comply with Rule No. 40. **ONLY ONLINE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL MIDNIGHT SEPTEMBER 1ST.**

1. Broilers must be ordered by County agents and Vo-Ag instructors prior to June 15th using forms distributed by each state chair. Each 4-H or FFA member will receive up to 25 birds. Forms will be distributed to each county agent and school Vo-Ag instructor in the counties listed in rule No. 40 of the catalog. If you have not received a form, please contact the broiler project chair for your state - Arkansas – Shaw nee Tichenor – phone: 479-484-7737 or email stichenor@uada.edu. 2. Broilers will be wing banded and distributed at Kay Rodgers Park during the first week of August and must be picked up by County agents or Vo-Ag instructors by the first week of August. Date August 3 at 3:00 P.M. If unable to pick up your birds, you may authorize someone else to accept the birds by sending a letter on Extension or school letterhead stating the name of the person who is authorized to pick up your birds. Shaw nee Tichenor or Jennifer Patterson will notify County agents and Vo-Ag instructions by letter as to time assigned for pick up of birds.

3. Broilers not wing banded will be ineligible to show.

4. Check in broilers Friday, September 23, 8 A.M. to Noon. Broiler check in deadline is Noon. \$3 per set.

5. BROILERS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED!

JUDGING WILL BEGIN FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 23 AT 1:00 P.M.

6. An entry is one pen of three broilers (either sex). Broilers provided by U.S. Poultry Science Department. Broilers will be 7 weeks of age at time of show.

7. Only one pen of broilers may be entered by each exhibitor.

8. The Grand and Reserve Champion, plus 3rd thru 9th place broiler pens will be sold in the Junior Livestock Auction with the receipts going to exhibitor.
