

Agricultural Mechanics Show

Entry Fee is \$10 per exhibitor per project. Entries Due September 1st, 2023.

Rules:

1. All Ag Mechanics projects are subject to 2023 general rules of the Arkansas Oklahoma State Fair. All exhibitors must agree to the rules.
2. Exhibitors must be an Arkansas/Oklahoma resident and enrolled in a qualifying County school or be a qualifying County resident and must be a qualifying FFA or 4H member. See General Rule #40 in catalog.
3. A project can be exhibited one time in the Arkansas/Oklahoma State Fair.
4. The project must have been constructed during the current school year associated with the event.
5. Each project must have a build list and pictures of the construction of the project in a portfolio.
6. The Ag. Mechanics Director must approve any signs or banners before being displayed on any of the projects.
7. All exhibitors must compete in a group class or individual. A group may be made up of 2-8 students.

Divisions

1. Trailers - These may include bumper pull trailers, gooseneck trailers, stock trailers, and other trailers
2. Agriculture Machinery and Equipment - These may include hay equipment, spray equipment, hydraulic equipment, shop equipment, truck equipment, tractor attachments, bumpers, headache racks, etc.
3. Livestock and Wildlife Equipment - This may include bits, spurs, tack, gates, chutes, stands, feeders, deer stands, hog traps, cleaning racks, etc.
4. Home Convenience - This division may include indoor/outdoor furniture, tables, bar stools, bookshelves, swings, benches, show boxes, animal feeders, fire pits, firewood racks, grills, etc.

**The AR/OK State Fair reserves the right to move any entry into another division if it is deemed to fit there.*

Projects will be judged on the following:

- A. Workmanship - 15 Points
- B. Design - 15 Points
- C. Practicality - 15 Points
- D. Degree of Difficulty - 20 Points
- E. Finish and Appearance - 15 Points
- F. Portfolio - 20 Points
