SPECIAL RULES

- 1. **Sanctioning:** This is a Combined for with ADGA. The order of the show is subject to change to facilitate timely running show.
- 2. **Registration Papers:** The original certificate is required at check-in for all animals six months of age or older and this MUST be shown to the Show Secretary. If transfered must be in ink and dated at appropriate time. If ADGA has made amendments then these will apply to the show if showing in the youth show must be in youth exhibitor's name only no co-owned animals.
- 3. Age: The base date for computing the age of the animal shall be September 30th.
- 4. **Group Classes:** All group classes of a breed must be made up of only those animals that have been shown by the exhibitor in the individual classes of that breed in this show, and must be entered on the official entry blank.
- 5. Milk out: There will be NO pre-show milk out. There will be a designated area to dispose of milk.
- 6. **Pens:** Pens will be assigned. No tents or tent like structures will be permitted in the Dairy Goat pen area. Backdrops and side curtains will be permitted on tack pens. Farm and club displays may be set up in Dairy Goat pen areas. Aisle ways must not be blocked. No guarantee if pens will be stalls or shorter pens. If you have goats that are more difficult to keep in may need to bring barrier for your pens.
- 7. **Tattoos:** All dairy goats entered in this Dairy Goat show must have a tattoo.
- 8. Exhibitor should be able to lead and maintain control of goat. Goat must be shown in chain or collar. If goat not controlled or leading may be excused from arena

Senior Dam and Daughter: To consist of dam and her daughter. Each entry must consist of one dam and one daughter (no trios) dam or daughter may be entered only once.

Senior Get of Sire: To consist of three does from the Senior Division, the get of one sire. Sire must be named. **Senior Produce of Dam:** To consist of two does from the Senior Division, the daughters of one dam. Dam must be named.

Senior Best Three Females: To consist of three Senior Does, all owned by exhibitor.

Dairy Herd: To consist of four does in milk, all owned by one exhibitor.

This show is open to all 4-H, FFA and ADGA youth ages 8-19 (not beyond 1 semester after high school graduation) from the following counties in Arkansas: Benton, Conway, Crawford, Franklin, Johnson, Logan, Perry, Polk, Pope, Scott, Sebastian, Washington and Yell. And the following counties in Oklahoma: Adair, Cherokee, Delaware, Haskell, Latimer, LeFlore, McCurtain, McIntosh, Muskogee, Pittsburg, Sequoyah and Wagoner.
- Youth Entries are automatically entered in Open Show. The show will be held at the same time, youth
 exhibitors will be placed among the open exhibitors but placed and paid according to standing in the youth
 entries.
- 3. **Registration Papers:** The original certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and MUST be shown to the Show Secretary at check-in. If transferred must be in ink and dated at appropriate time. If ADGA has made amendments then these will apply to the show. If showing in youth show must be in youth exhibitors name only no co-owned animals.
